Dear Lender and Servicer:

Effective May 1, 2022, Educational Credit Management Corporation (ECMC) will become the designated guarantor for the Federal Family Education Loan Program (FFELP) portfolio previously held by Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC). ECMC is working closely with ISAC to plan for the transition.

As the new guarantor of the former ISAC FFELP portfolio, we are committed to a smooth transition for you and your borrowers. We plan to begin the transition of the portfolio from ISAC to ECMC beginning on April 28, 2022, with an anticipated completion date of May 1, 2022.
